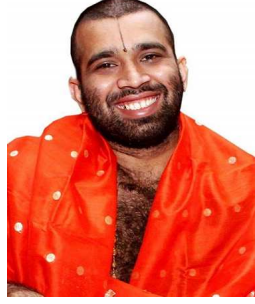

2. A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE:

Dr. Sreenivasa Padiar LM&S (Homoeo) and Dr. Madhava Padiar (M&S) (Homoeo) who were private Medical Practitioners in Homoeopathy, established two Institutions namely “ The Royal College of Homoeopathic Physicians:” & “The Free to the Poor Dispensary” at Market Road, in the heart of the Kochi City as early as in 1920 to propagate Homoeopathic System of Medicine in this part of the country. They were veteran Homoeopathic Physicians of the erstwhile Cochin State. “The Royal College of Homoeopathic Physicians” was later renamed as “Dr. Padiar Memorial Homoeopathic Medical College” and is was confirmed by the G.O.(MS) No. 271/75/HD. Dt. 4.11.1975 by the Government of Kerala. This College has been accorded the status of Linguistic Minority Institution by Government of Kerala wide its order Rt. No. 792/83 HD dt. 28.03.1983.

3. COURSE OFFERED:-

As per the Notification No. 20833/leg C3/2009/Law, Kerala University of Health Sciences came into existence on 07.12.2009. The students admitted to I BHMS Course from 2010-'11 are enrolled in the Medical University. Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery (BHMS), is 4 and ½ year Degree Course with 1 year Compulsory Rotatory Internship (allowance paid by Govt.)

9. UNIFORM, BEHAVIOUR & GENERAL DISCIPLINE: The male students have to wear pants and shirts, while female students have to wear Churidar. All students must dress modestly. 10. CRITERIA OF ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

KEAM 2020 PROSPECTUS - Admissions to Kerala Engineering, Architecture and Medical Courses.

- i. Nationality – Applicants must be Citizens of India
- ii. Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala or Examinations recognized equivalent thereto, with 50% marks in Biology/Biotechnology separately, and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/ Biotechnology put together, are eligible in the absence of Biology, Biotechnology will be considered as subject for academic eligibility SC/ST/OBC candidates shall be eligible for relation in minimum marks as per the norms prescribed.
- iii. Rounding off of the percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is not permitted.
- iv. Candidates who have not passed their qualifying exam from the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, CBSE or ICSE shall provide an equivalency certificate obtained from the concerned university.

- v. **Only those candidates who qualifies NEET UG-as per the qualifying criteria prescribed in the information bulletin of NEET UG shall be eligible to apply for admission and Only candidates registered his/or her NEET Rank in KEAM is eligible.**
- vi. **Applicants should possess certificate of good conduct and character issued from the institution last studied.**
- vii. **Candidate can apply strictly through the fulfillment of directions prescribed in the KEAM 2020 Prospectus.**
- viii. **NEET notification as a whole including the “Merit list and qualifying Criteria” of the NEET information bulletin issued by CBSE, obtain minimum of marks at 50th percentile. AYUSH-UG Courses shall be mandatory through merit list and qualifying criteria of NEET from the A.Y. 2020-21.**
- ix. **Documents to be produced at the time of admission**
 - 1. **Date of Birth Certificate (SSLC or equivalent).**
 - 2. **Transfer Certificate from the Institution last attended and Conduct Certificate.**
 - 3. **Original mark sheet & certificate of Higher Secondary or equivalent.**

 - 5. **Data sheet of KEAM 2020 issued by office of the CEE, Kerala.**
 - 6. **Admit card and Score Card of NEET 2020.**
 - 7. **Eligibility certificate from any university in Kerala, in the case of candidates who have passed a qualifying examination other than HSE/VHSE conducted by Government of Kerala or the examination conducted by CBSE and CISCE.**
 - 8. **Physical Fitness Certificate.**
 - 9. **Community Certificate from the concerned Revenue Officials.**
 - 10. **3 (Three) Pass Port Size Photographs.**
 - 11. **Proof of identity (Aadhar)**
 - 12. **Any other documents required by the Head of Institution.**

11. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

As per Clause 2.5.2 and 4.1.12, 5.1, 5.2 Annexure – IV (1) and IV (2) KEAM Prospectus 2020, out of 50 seats, 8 Seats are reserved under management quota. The management seats will be filled from Konkani Linguistic Minority Candidates fulfilling eligibility criteria, as per inter se merit. If there is any vacancy in the management seats after admitting Konkani Linguistic Minority Students as above, the remaining seats shall be filled from candidates from general category, as per inter se merit.

Only online applications will be entertained for management seats. Application can be submitted online through link attached to www.drpadiarhomoeopathicmedicalcollege.in
An application fee of Rs.3,000/- must be paid ONLINE. Fee once paid is non refundable.

12. FEE STRUCTURE

All students are liable to pay Tuition fee, Special fees, Interest free deposit in accordance with the order of AFRC (Admission Fee Regulatory Committee for Medical Education, Kerala) as per S.11 of Act 15 of 2017 Passed by the Kerala Legislative Assembly (The Kerala Medical Education Regulation & Control of Admission to Private Medical Educational Institutions Act 2017).

The admission procedure and fee structure are based on the provision of Act 15 of 2017 (The Kerala Medical Education Regulation & Control of Admission to Private Medical Educational Institutions Act 2017).

This Institution will not retain the first year tuition and other fees, if the student discontinues the course before the last date of closing of admission.

This Institution will not retain the Certificate and TC of student leaving the College, and same shall be released, on the student with one of his/her parents executing a bond undertaking to pay the amount that may be ordered by the Committee or the Court of Law.
